5 On page 10, after line 6 of the amendment, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 12. RCW 28B.15.202 and 1985 c 390 s 19 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 Tuition fees and services and activities fees at the University of
9 Washington and at Washington State University for other than summer
10 quarters or semesters shall be as follows:

11 (1) For full time resident undergraduate students and all other
12 full time resident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled
13 in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of
14 dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, the total tuition
15 fees shall be one-third of the per student undergraduate educational
16 costs at the state universities computed as provided in RCW 28B.15.067
17 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic
18 year shall be (~~one hundred and twenty dollars~~) six percent of total
19 tuition fees.

20 (2) For full time resident graduate students not enrolled in
21 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental
22 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, the total tuition fees
23 shall be twenty-three percent of the per student graduate educational
24 costs at the state universities computed as provided in RCW 28B.15.067
25 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic
26 year shall be (~~one hundred and twenty dollars~~) four percent of total
27 tuition fees.

1 (3) For full time resident students enrolled in programs leading to
2 the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor
3 of veterinary medicine, the total tuition fees shall be one hundred
4 sixty-seven percent of such fees charged in subsection (2) (~~above~~) of
5 this section: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic year
6 shall be (~~three hundred and forty two dollars~~) six percent of total
7 tuition fees.

8 (4) For full time nonresident undergraduate students and such other
9 full time nonresident students not in graduate study programs or
10 enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine,
11 doctor of dental surgery, or doctor of veterinary medicine, the total
12 tuition fees shall be one hundred percent of the per student
13 undergraduate educational costs at the state universities computed as
14 provided in RCW 28B.15.067 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building
15 fees for each academic year shall be (~~three hundred and fifty four~~
16 ~~dollars~~) six percent of total tuition fees.

17 (5) For full time nonresident graduate students not enrolled in
18 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental
19 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, the total tuition fees
20 shall be (~~four thousand and seventy four dollars, and thereafter such~~
21 ~~fees shall be~~) sixty percent of the per student graduate educational
22 costs at the state universities computed as provided in RCW 28B.15.067
23 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic
24 year shall be (~~three hundred and fifty four dollars~~) four percent of
25 total tuition fees.

26 (6) For full time nonresident students enrolled in programs leading
27 to the degree(~~s~~) of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and
28 doctor of veterinary medicine, the total tuition fees shall be one
29 hundred sixty-seven percent of such fees charged in subsection (5)

1 ((above)) of this section: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each
2 academic year shall be (~~five hundred and fifty five dollars.~~
3 ~~(7)~~) four percent of total tuition fees.

4 (7) The boards of regents of each of the state universities shall
5 charge and collect equally from each of the students registering at the
6 particular institution and included in subsections (1) through (6)
7 hereof a services and activities fee which for each year of the 1981-83
8 biennium shall not exceed one hundred and thirty-eight dollars. In
9 subsequent biennia the board of regents may increase the existing fee,
10 consistent with budgeting procedures set forth in RCW 28B.15.045, by a
11 percentage not to exceed the percentage increase in tuition fees
12 authorized in subsection (1) ((above)) of this section: PROVIDED, That
13 such percentage increase shall not apply to that portion of the
14 services and activities fee previously committed to the repayment of
15 bonded debt. The services and activities fee committee provided for in
16 RCW 28B.15.045 may initiate a request to the governing board for a fee
17 increase."

18 "Sec. 13. RCW 28B.15.502 and 1991 c 353 s 2 are each amended to
19 read as follows:

20 Tuition fees and services and activities fees at each community
21 college other than (~~at~~) summer quarters shall be as follows:

22 (1) For full time resident students, the total tuition fees shall
23 be twenty-three percent of the per student educational costs at the
24 community colleges computed as provided in RCW 28B.15.067 and
25 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic year
26 shall be (~~one hundred and twenty seven dollars and fifty cents~~)
27 fifteen percent of tuition fees.

28 (2) For full time nonresident students, the total tuition fees
29 shall be one hundred percent of the per student educational costs at

1 the community colleges computed as provided in RCW 28B.15.067 and
2 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for each academic year
3 shall be (~~four hundred and three dollars and fifty cents~~) eleven
4 percent of tuition fees.

5 (3) The boards of trustees of each of the state community colleges
6 shall charge and collect equally from each of the students registering
7 at the particular institution and included in subsections (1) and (2)
8 (~~hereof~~) of this section a services and activities fee which for each
9 year of the 1981-83 biennium shall not exceed sixty-four dollars and
10 fifty cents. In subsequent biennia the board of trustees may increase
11 the existing fee, consistent with budgeting procedures set forth in RCW
12 28B.15.045, by a percentage not to exceed the percentage increase in
13 tuition fees authorized in subsection (1) above: PROVIDED, That such
14 percentage increase shall not apply to that portion of the services and
15 activities fee previously committed to the repayment of bonded debt.
16 The services and activities fee committee provided for in RCW
17 28B.15.045 may initiate a request to the governing board for a fee
18 increase.

19 (4) Tuition and services and activities fees consistent with the
20 above schedule (~~will~~) shall be fixed by the state board for community
21 and technical colleges for summer school students unless the community
22 college charges fees in accordance with RCW 28B.15.515.

23 The board of trustees shall charge such fees for ungraded courses,
24 noncredit courses, community services courses, and self-supporting
25 short courses as it, in its discretion, may determine, not inconsistent
26 with the rules and regulations of the state board for community
27 (~~college education~~) and technical colleges."

28 "Sec. 14. RCW 28B.15.402 and 1989 c 245 s 1 are each amended to
29 read as follows:

1 Tuition fees and services and activities fees at the regional
2 universities and The Evergreen State College for other than summer
3 quarters or semesters shall be as follows:

4 (1) For full time resident undergraduate students and all other
5 full time resident students not in graduate study programs, the total
6 tuition fees shall be one-fourth of the per student undergraduate
7 educational costs at the regional universities computed as provided in
8 RCW 28B.15.067 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for
9 each academic year shall be (~~((seventy six dollars and fifty cents))~~)
10 five percent of total tuition fees.

11 (2) For full time resident graduate students, the total tuition
12 fees shall be twenty-three percent of the per student graduate
13 educational costs at the regional universities computed as provided in
14 RCW 28B.15.067 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for
15 each academic year shall be (~~((seventy six dollars and fifty cents))~~)
16 three percent of total tuition fees.

17 (3) For full time nonresident undergraduate students and all other
18 full time nonresident students not in graduate study programs, the
19 total tuition fees shall be one hundred percent of the per student
20 undergraduate educational costs at the regional universities computed
21 as provided in RCW 28B.15.067 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the
22 building fees for each academic year shall be (~~((two hundred and
23 ninety five dollars and fifty cents))~~) five percent of total tuition
24 fees.

25 (4) For full time nonresident graduate students, the total of
26 tuition fees shall be seventy-five percent of the per student graduate
27 educational costs at the regional universities computed as provided in
28 RCW 28B.15.067 and 28B.15.070: PROVIDED, That the building fees for
29 each academic year shall be (~~((two hundred and ninety five dollars and
30 fifty cents))~~) four percent of total tuition fees.

1 (5) The boards of trustees of each of the regional universities and
2 The Evergreen State College shall charge and collect equally from each
3 of the students registering at the particular institution and included
4 in subsections (1) through (4) (~~hereof~~) of this section a services
5 and activities fee which for each year of the 1981-83 biennium shall
6 not exceed one hundred eighty-four dollars and fifty cents. In
7 subsequent biennia the board of trustees may increase the existing fee,
8 consistent with budgeting procedures set forth in RCW 28B.15.045, by a
9 percentage not to exceed the percentage increase in tuition fees
10 authorized in subsection (1) (~~above~~) of this section: PROVIDED, That
11 such percentage increase shall not apply to that portion of the
12 services and activities fee previously committed to the repayment of
13 bonded debt. The services and activities fee committee provided for in
14 RCW 28B.15.045 may initiate a request to the governing board for a fee
15 increase.

16 (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 28B.15.067, for the
17 1989-91 biennium the undergraduate and graduate cost relationship
18 developed by the 1987 cost study for Central Washington University
19 shall be used to establish tuition fees for the regional universities
20 and The Evergreen State College."

21 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
22 internal references accordingly.
