10 (1) Any convicted person undergoing sentence in the penitentiary or
11 the reformatory, not sooner released under the provisions of this
12 chapter, shall, in accordance with the provisions of law, be discharged
13 from custody on serving the maximum punishment provided by law for the
14 offense of which such person was convicted, or the maximum term fixed
15 by the court where the law does not provide for a maximum term. ((The
16 board shall not, however, until his maximum term expires, release a
17 prisoner, unless in its opinion his rehabilitation has been complete
18 and he is a fit subject for release))

19 (2) When the board reviews the parole eligibility of an offender
20 for all offenders whose minimum terms have been set according to RCW
21 9.95.009(2), the board shall not release the offender unless the board
22 determines that the offender does not present a serious risk to the
23 community on parole."
