1            AN ACT Relating to recycling on state lands; adding new sections to  
2 chapter 43.51 RCW; adding new sections to chapter 53.08 RCW; and making  
3 an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**            (1) The commission shall provide waste  
6 reduction and recycling information in each state park campground and  
7 in each state park facility developed for day use by July 1, 1992.

8            (2) The commission shall provide recycling receptacles in at least  
9 fifteen state park campgrounds and in fifteen day-use areas by July 1,  
10 1993. The receptacles shall be clearly marked for the disposal of at  
11 least the following recyclable materials: Aluminum, glass, and paper.

12            (3) The commission is authorized to enter into agreements with any  
13 person, company, or nonprofit organization to provide for the

1 collection and transport of recyclable materials and related activities  
2 under this section.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The commission shall, at the earliest  
4 available opportunity, amend its leases to require park concessionaires  
5 to:

6 (1) Recycle aluminum, glass, and paper and to make such services  
7 available to the public where appropriate; and

8 (2) Meet all state and federal requirements for the procurement of  
9 products containing recovered materials.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Ports districts shall provide recycling  
11 receptacles in areas frequented by the public, including but not  
12 limited to, harbors, airports, and marinas owned or operated by a port  
13 district. The receptacles shall be clearly marked for the disposal of  
14 at least the following recyclable materials: Aluminum, glass, and  
15 paper.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Each port district shall meet all state  
17 and federal requirements for the procurement of products containing  
18 recovered materials.

19 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act are each  
20 added to chapter 43.51 RCW.

21 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** Sections 3 and 4 of this act are each  
22 added to chapter 53.08 RCW.

23 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars,  
24 or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the

1 biennium ending June 30, 1993, from the general fund to the parks and  
2 recreation commission for the purposes of implementing section 1 of  
3 this act.
