
SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1047

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to state civil and higher education employees;
2 adding a new section to chapter 28B.16 RCW; and adding a new section to
3 chapter 41.06 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.16 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 All higher education institutions and postsecondary institutions
8 shall provide paid leave for employees subject to this chapter who are
9 in training or on call as volunteer fire fighters, law enforcement
10 officers, search and rescue team members, or emergency medical
11 technicians. Paid leave for training purposes described in this
12 section shall not exceed ten days during each calendar year. The
13 higher education personnel board shall monitor the amount of leave
14 taken by employees who are in training or on call as described in this
15 section, and the board shall provide a report to the legislature by

1 January 15, 1992, describing leave taken or requested under this
2 section.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.06 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 All state agencies and departments shall provide paid leave for
6 employees subject to this chapter who are in training or on call as
7 volunteer fire fighters, law enforcement officers, search and rescue
8 team members, or emergency medical technicians. Paid leave for
9 training purposes described in this section shall not exceed ten days
10 during each calendar year. The state personnel board shall monitor the
11 amount of leave taken by employees who are in training or on call as
12 described in this section, and the board shall provide a report to the
13 legislature by January 15, 1992, describing leave taken or requested
14 under this section.
