1 AN ACT Relating to education; adding new sections to chapter
2 28A.600 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The community service as an alternative
5 to suspension program is established to provide an appropriate
6 educational alternative to out of school short or long-term suspension
7 of students in grades six through twelve. One or more schools within
8 a school district may assign students to community service activities
9 in place of out of school suspension. In such cases it is the
10 responsibility of the school district to coordinate the placement and
11 supervision of such students in the community.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The superintendent of public instruction
13 may grant such funds as are appropriated to selected school districts

1 or school district cooperatives for the purpose of establishing and
2 maintaining community service as an alternative to suspension projects.

3 Grant applications shall:

4 (1) Enumerate specific activities to be carried out as a part of
5 the project;

6 (2) Include budget plans for the project and any additional
7 anticipated sources of funding, including private grants and
8 contributions, if any;

9 (3) Provide plans for the supervision of students when they are
10 involved in community service activities;

11 (4) Identify evaluation and accountability measures to be used to
12 measure project success; and

13 (5) Include written statements of support from the district's board
14 of directors, the district's superintendent, the principals and staffs
15 of the buildings affected by the grant, as well as statements of
16 support from parents, businesses, public agencies, and community
17 organizations.

18 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The superintendent of public instruction
19 shall adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW to carry out the purposes of
20 sections 1 and 2 of this act.

21 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Each grant recipient shall submit such
22 reports regarding the progress of the project as are specified by the
23 superintendent of public instruction. The superintendent of public
24 instruction shall submit a report to the legislature, including its
25 findings and specific recommendations, evaluating the progress of the
26 program, by December 15, 1994.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act are
2 each added to chapter 28A.600 RCW.
