1 AN ACT Relating to electrical construction; and adding a new
2 section to chapter 19.28 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.28 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 Completion of at least sixteen hours per year of approved
7 continuing education coursework is required prior to the renewal of
8 electrician certificates of competency and electrical training
9 certificates under RCW 19.28.550.

10 (1) To receive credit for continuing education, the following
11 requirements must be met:

12 (a) Courses or seminars must have prior approval of curriculum by
13 the state electrical board;

1 (b) Instructors must be certified by the state electrical board
2 prior to presentation of course or seminar;

3 (c) Representatives of the department or state electrical board
4 shall be able to attend and monitor the courses or seminars without
5 charge;

6 (d) Completion certificates for courses or seminars, and the hours
7 attended, shall be attached to the application for certificate renewal
8 for a minimum verification of sixteen hours per year;

9 (e) In general, the subject matter of the courses or seminars must
10 be the national electrical code or advances in the electrical industry;

11 (f) Request for approval of courses, seminars, and instructors must
12 be made to the state electrical board no later than the next board
13 meeting preceding the seminar; and

14 (g) Attendance lists and the hours attended by each person shall be
15 forwarded to the state electrical board by the instructor.

16 (2) The certificates required by subsection (1)(d) of this section
17 must contain the following:

18 (a) The date, title, and location of the course;

19 (b) The duration of the course in number of hours;

20 (c) The name of the instructor;

21 (d) The name of the sponsoring agency; and

22 (e) The name of the person completing the course.
