1 AN ACT Relating to instruction in renewable natural resources as
2 part of the common schools curriculum; and amending RCW 28A.230.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.230.020 and 1991 c 116 s 6 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 All common schools shall give instruction in reading, penmanship,
7 orthography, written and mental arithmetic, geography, the history of
8 the United States, English grammar, physiology and hygiene with special
9 reference to the effects of alcohol and drug abuse on the human system,
10 science with special reference to the environment, including renewable
11 natural resources, and such other studies as may be prescribed by rule
12 or regulation of the state board of education. All teachers shall
13 stress the importance of the cultivation of manners, the fundamental
14 principles of honesty, honor, industry and economy, the minimum
15 requisites for good health including the beneficial effect of physical
16 exercise and methods to prevent exposure to and transmission of
17 sexually transmitted diseases, and the worth of kindness to all living

1 creatures and the land. The prevention of child abuse may be offered
2 as part of the curriculum in the common schools.
