1 AN ACT Relating to creating an inventory system for state-owned or
2 leased facilities; and adding a new section to chapter 43.82 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.82 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The office of financial management shall develop and maintain
7 an inventory system to account for all owned or leased facilities
8 utilized by state government. At a minimum, the inventory system must
9 include the location, type, and size of each facility. In addition,
10 for owned facilities, the inventory system must include the date and
11 cost of original construction and the cost of any major remodelling or
12 renovation. The system must be developed by January 1, 1994, and the
13 initial inventory must be completed by June 30, 1994. The inventory
14 must be updated by June 30 of each subsequent year.

15 (2) All agencies, departments, boards, commissions, and
16 institutions of the state of Washington shall provide to the office of
17 financial management a complete inventory of owned and leased
18 facilities by May 30, 1994. The inventory must be updated and
19 submitted to the office of financial management by May 30 of each

1 subsequent year. The inventories required under this subsection must
2 be submitted in a standard format prescribed by the office of financial
3 management.

4 (3) For the purposes of this section, "facilities" means buildings
5 and other structures with walls and a roof. "Facilities" does not mean
6 roads, bridges, parking areas, utility systems, and other similar
7 improvements to real property.

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
