1 AN ACT Relating to historical activities; amending RCW 43.19.500;
2 and adding a new section to chapter 27.34 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 27.34 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The Washington state historical society shall be responsible for
7 the preservation and interpretation of Washington's history and culture
8 within the legislative building. In meeting this mission the society
9 shall regularly consult with the tenants of the legislative building,
10 including the secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house
11 of representatives and the executive offices housed in the legislative
12 building, as well as the department of general administration. The
13 society shall be compensated for the costs of conducting this
14 interpretive program out of the facilities and services revolving fund.

15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.19.500 and 1982 c 41 s 2 are each amended to read
16 as follows:

17 There is hereby created a fund within the state treasury designated
18 as the "department of general administration facilities and services

1 revolving fund". Such revolving fund shall be used by the department
2 of general administration for the payment of certain costs, expenses,
3 and charges, as hereinafter specified, incurred by it in the operation
4 and administration of the department in the rendering of services, the
5 furnishing or supplying of equipment, supplies and materials, and for
6 providing or allocating facilities, including the operation,
7 maintenance, rehabilitation, or furnishings thereof to other agencies,
8 offices, departments, activities, and other entities enumerated in RCW
9 43.01.090 and including the rendering of services in acquiring real
10 estate under RCW 43.82.010. The department shall treat the rendering
11 of services in acquiring real estate as a separate operating entity
12 within the fund for financial accounting and control.

13 The schedule of services, facilities, equipment, supplies,
14 materials, maintenance, rehabilitation, furnishings, operations, and
15 administration to be so financed and recovered shall be determined
16 jointly by the director of general administration and the director of
17 financial management, in amounts which, together with any other income
18 or appropriation, will provide the department of general administration
19 with funds to meet its anticipated expenditures during any allotment
20 period.

21 The director of general administration may promulgate rules and
22 regulations governing the provisions of RCW 43.01.090 and this section
23 and the relationships and procedures between the department of general
24 administration and such other entities.

25 Moneys may be expended from the department of general
26 administration facilities and services revolving fund for the purposes
27 set out under section 1 of this act.

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
