Brief Description: Establishing a student-teacher-employer-parent contract for working students.

**HB 2545 - DIGEST**

(SEE ALSO PROPOSED 1ST SUB)

Authorizes students age sixteen or older who maintain a grade point average of 2.0 or better to enter into a student-teacher-employer-parent contract to allow the student to work.

Requires periodic evaluation of the impact the employment has on school progress.
