## SHB 2155

**Title:** An act relating to refunds of overpayments of license fees and motor vehicle excise taxes.

**Brief Description:** Clarifying criteria for refund of overpayments of vehicle and vessel license fees.

**Background:** The Department of Licensing (DOL) has limited authority to issue motor vehicle excise tax refunds or refunds of vessel registration fees.

**Summary of Bill:** The Department of Licensing may refund motor vehicle excises taxes and vessel registration fees in the following circumstances:

- (1) if the vehicle or vessel for which the renewal license is purchased is destroyed before the beginning date of the registration period;
- (2) if the registered vehicle or vessel is permanently moved from the state either before the registration period begins or during the registration period (in the latter case, only a pro rata share of the taxes and fees is refunded); or
- (3) if the vehicle or vessel license is purchased after the owner sold the vehicle or vessel.
