**Background:** Persons 70 years old and older qualify for reduced fee fishing licenses.

Many other senior citizen reduced fee benefits begin at age 65.

**Summary of Bill:** Reduced fee senior citizen fishing licenses are issued to persons over 65 years old.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Requested on January 16, 1996.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
