1 AN ACT Relating to personal service contracts; amending RCW
2 42.52.030; and adding a new section to chapter 39.29 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 39.29 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 No member of the legislature may enter into a personal service
7 contract as defined in this chapter.

8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.52.030 and 1994 c 154 s 103 are each amended to
9 read as follows:

10 (1) No state officer or state employee may be beneficially
11 interested, directly or indirectly, in a contract, sale, lease,
12 purchase, or grant that may be made by, through, or is under the
13 supervision of the officer or employee, in whole or in part, or accept,
14 directly or indirectly, any compensation, gratuity, or reward from any
15 other person beneficially interested in the contract, sale, lease,
16 purchase, or grant.

17 (2) No state officer or state employee may participate in a
18 transaction involving the state in his or her official capacity with a

1 person of which the officer or employee is an officer, agent, employee,
2 or member, or in which the officer or employee owns a beneficial
3 interest.

4 (3) No member of the legislature may enter into a personal service
5 contract as defined in RCW 39.29.006.
