1 AN ACT Relating to the Washington state patrol retirement system;
2 and adding a new section to chapter 43.43 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 Any member of the retirement system who, on or after January 1,
7 1995, is on leave of absence for the purpose of serving as a state
8 legislator, may elect to continue to be a member of this retirement
9 system. The member shall continue to receive service credit subject to
10 the following:

11 (1) The member will not receive more than one month's service
12 credit in a calendar month;

13 (2) Employer contributions shall continue to be paid by the
14 employer;

15 (3) Employee contributions shall continue to be collected by the
16 employer and paid to the department;

17 (4) Contributions shall be based on the regular compensation which
18 the member would have received had such a member not served in the
19 legislature;

1 (5) The service and compensation credit under this section shall be
2 granted only for periods during which the legislature is in session;
3 and

4 (6) No service credit for service as a legislator will be allowed
5 after a member separates from employment with the Washington state
6 patrol.
