1 AN ACT Relating to marking the drivers' licenses of drunk drivers;
2 amending RCW 46.20.161; adding a new section to chapter 66.44 RCW; and
3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.161 and 1990 c 250 s 40 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 The department, upon receipt of a fee of fourteen dollars, which
8 includes the fee for the required photograph, shall issue to every
9 applicant qualifying therefor a driver's license, which license shall
10 bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, the full
11 name, date of birth, Washington residence address, and a brief
12 description of the licensee, and either a facsimile of the signature of
13 the licensee or a space upon which the licensee shall write his usual
14 signature with pen and ink immediately upon receipt of the license. No
15 license is valid until it has been so signed by the licensee.

16 The department shall prominently and permanently mark with the
17 letters "DUI" the front of a license issued to a person convicted of a
18 violation of RCW 46.61.502 or 46.61.504. The department shall continue
19 the marking on each renewal license issued to the person.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 66.44 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 It is unlawful for a retail licensee to knowingly sell liquor to a
4 person whose driver's license has been marked "DUI" under RCW
5 46.20.161.
