1            AN ACT Relating to authorizing removal of motor vehicles bought or  
2 received in pledge by a pawnbroker from the pawnbroker's place of  
3 business; and amending RCW 19.60.050.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.60.050 and 1991 c 323 s 5 are each amended to read  
6 as follows:

7            Property bought or received in pledge by any pawnbroker shall not  
8 be removed from that place of business, except when redeemed by, or  
9 returned to the owner, within thirty days after the receipt of the  
10 property. However, a motor vehicle bought or received in pledge may be  
11 removed from the pawnbroker's place of business to a secured location  
12 if the owner of the vehicle consents to the removal in writing.  
13 Property shall at all times during the ordinary hours of business be  
14 open to inspection to any commissioned law enforcement officer of the  
15 state or any of its political subdivisions.
