BACKGROUND:

Restrictions on mailings that a legislative body may make with public funds during the 12 months period preceding the last day for certifying election results for the legislative election office. During this 12 months period, a legislative body may mail one identical newsletter to constituents later than 30 days after the start of a regular legislative session and one identical newsletter to constituents later than 60 days after the end of a regular legislative session.

However, a legislative body may use public funds to mail an individual letter to an individual constituent who has contacted the legislature concerning the subject matter of the letter during his or her current term of office or if the constituent holds a governmental office with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the letter.

The legislative ethics board consists of nine members, two senators, two members of the house of representatives, and five citizens. Among other duties, the legislative ethics board develops educational materials and training for legislative ethics for legislators and legislative employees, issues advisory opinions, and investigates complaints.

SUMMARY:

The authority of a legislature is expanded to use public funds to mail individual letters to individual constituents during the 12 months period preceding the last day for certifying election results for the legislative election office.

A legislative body may use public funds to mail an individual letter to a constituent during this period if the constituent has received an award or honor for extraordinary civic or academic achievement as defined by rule of the legislative ethics board.

FISCAL NOTE: Not requested.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bills passed.
