7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.185
8 RCW to read as follows:

9 In order to ensure that school districts are meeting the
10 requirements of an approved program for highly capable students, the
11 superintendent of public instruction shall monitor highly capable
12 programs at least once every five years. Monitoring shall begin during
13 the 2002-03 school year.

14 Any program review and monitoring under this section may be
15 conducted concurrently with other program reviews and monitoring
16 conducted by the office of the superintendent of public instruction.
17 In its review, the office shall monitor program components that include
18 but need not be limited to the process used by the district to identify
19 and reach out to highly capable students with diverse talents and from
20 diverse backgrounds, and district expenditures used to enrich or expand
21 opportunities for these students.

22 Beginning June 30, 2003, and every five years thereafter, the
23 office of the superintendent of public instruction shall submit a
24 report to the education committees of the house of representatives and
25 the senate that provides a brief description of the various
26 instructional programs offered to highly capable students.

27 The superintendent of public instruction may adopt rules under
28 chapter 34.05 RCW to implement this section."

32 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "students;" strike the
33 remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new section to chapter
34 28A.185 RCW."
