6 On page 9, beginning on line 32, after "agreement." strike all  
7 material through "individual." on line 35 and insert "The performance  
8 agreement may include waivers of state laws or local policies and  
9 agreements if waivers are necessary to improve student learning and to  
10 implement the performance agreement and the employee bargaining  
11 representative organizations show evidence of support of the waivers."

12 On page 12, after line 28, insert the following:

13 "(c) Any waiver of state laws or local policies and agreements  
14 under an intervention plan shall be considered an educational policy  
15 decision. If any such waiver requires a renegotiation of a collective  
16 bargaining agreement, then the parties to the collective bargaining  
17 agreement shall enter into bargaining subject to the procedures under  
18 chapter 41.56 or 41.59 RCW, as applicable, on the effect of school-  
19 specific issues for inclusion in an addendum to the collective  
20 bargaining agreement. If agreement is not reached within forty-five  
21 days, then the public employment relations commission shall mediate."

22 On page 33, beginning on line 11, strike all material through  
23 "act." on line 15 and insert the following:

24 "Any waiver of state laws or local policies and agreements under an  
25 intervention plan under chapter 28A.655 RCW shall be considered an  
26 educational policy decision. If any such waiver requires a  
27 renegotiation of a collective bargaining agreement, then the parties to  
28 the collective bargaining agreement shall enter into bargaining subject  
29 to the procedures in this chapter on the effect of school-specific  
30 issues for inclusion in an addendum to the collective bargaining  
31 agreement. If agreement is not reached within forty-five days, then  
32 the public employment relations commission shall mediate."

33 On page 33, beginning on line 18, strike all material through  
34 "act." on line 22 and insert the following:

1 "Any waiver of state laws or local policies and agreements under an  
2 intervention plan under chapter 28A.655 RCW shall be considered an  
3 educational policy decision. If any such waiver requires a  
4 renegotiation of a collective bargaining agreement, then the parties to  
5 the collective bargaining agreement shall enter into bargaining subject  
6 to the procedures in this chapter on the effect of school-specific  
7 issues for inclusion in an addendum to the collective bargaining  
8 agreement. If agreement is not reached within forty-five days, then  
9 the public employment relations commission shall mediate."
