2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 707.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
3 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

4 **MISCELLANEOUS GOODS AND SERVICES.** The director of financial
5 management shall reduce allotments from general fund--state
6 appropriations in this act for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$200,000,000
7 to reflect a seventeen percent reduction in expenditures from the 1999-
8 01 biennium. The amount of the allotment reduction shall be placed in
9 reserve status.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 708.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
11 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

12 **FURNISHINGS AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASE REDUCTION.** The director of
13 financial management shall reduce allotments from general fund--state
14 appropriations in this act for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$60,000,000 to
15 reflect a freeze on state agency equipment purchases for the remainder
16 of the 2001-03 biennium. The amount of the allotment reduction shall
17 be placed in reserve status.

18 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 709.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
19 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

20 **EMPLOYEE TRAVEL REDUCTION.** The director of financial management
21 shall reduce allotments from general fund--state appropriations in this
22 act for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$22,000,000 to reflect the
23 elimination of non-essential travel by state employees and officials.
24 The amount of the allotment reduction shall be placed in reserve
25 status.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 710.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
27 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

28 **CONSULTING CONTRACTS.** The director of financial management shall
29 reduce allotments from general fund--state appropriations in this act
30 for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$13,000,000 to reflect a seventeen

1 percent reduction on such expenditures from the 1999-01 biennium. The
2 amount of the allotment reduction shall be placed in reserve status.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 711.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
4 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

5 **TRAINING RETREATS AND CONFERENCES.** The director of financial
6 management shall reduce allotments from general fund--state
7 appropriations in this act for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$7,000,000 to
8 reflect a thirty three percent reduction on such expenditures from the
9 1999-01 biennium. The amount of the allotment reduction shall be
10 placed in reserve status.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 712.** A new section is added to 2001 2nd sp.s.
12 c 7 (uncodified) to read as follows:

13 **LEGISLATIVE MAILINGS.** The director of financial management shall
14 reduce allotments from general fund--state appropriations in this act
15 for the 2001-2003 biennium by \$1,000,000 to reflect a reduction of
16 legislators' mailings. The amount of the allotment reduction shall be
17 placed in reserve status."

18 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
19 references accordingly.
