1 AN ACT Relating to personal use shellfish and seaweed licenses; and
2 amending RCW 77.32.520.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.520 and 2000 c 107 s 27 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) A personal use shellfish and seaweed license is required for
7 all persons other than residents or nonresidents under fifteen years of
8 age to fish for, take, dig for, or possess seaweed or shellfish for
9 personal use from state waters or offshore waters including national
10 park beaches.

11 (2) The fees for annual personal use shellfish and seaweed licenses
12 are:

13 (a) For a resident fifteen years of age or older, seven dollars;

14 (b) For a nonresident fifteen years of age or older, twenty
15 dollars; and

16 (c) For a senior, five dollars.

17 (3) The license fee for a two-day personal use shellfish and
18 seaweed license is six dollars for residents or nonresidents fifteen
19 years of age or older.

1 (~~(4) The personal use shellfish and seaweed license shall be~~
2 ~~visible on the licensee while harvesting shellfish or seaweed.)~~)
