1 AN ACT Relating to the human immunodeficiency virus insurance
2 program; adding a new section to chapter 43.70 RCW; repealing RCW
3 74.09.757; and providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.09.757 (Acquired human
6 immunodeficiency syndrome insurance program (HIV/AIDS)) and 1993 c 264
7 s 1 & 1989 c 260 s 3 are each repealed.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 RCW
9 to read as follows:

10 (1) "Human immunodeficiency virus insurance program," as used in
11 this section, means the program that provides health insurance coverage
12 for individuals with human immunodeficiency virus, as defined in RCW
13 70.24.017(7), who meet eligibility requirements established by the
14 department of health.

15 (2) The department of health may pay for health insurance coverage
16 on behalf of persons with human immunodeficiency virus, who meet
17 department eligibility requirements, and who are eligible for
18 "continuation coverage" as provided by the federal consolidated omnibus

1 budget reconciliation act of 1985, group health insurance policies, or
2 individual policies.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect July 1, 2002.

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
