1 AN ACT Relating to crimes involving drivers' licenses and
2 identicards; amending RCW 46.20.0921; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.0921 and 1990 c 210 s 3 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) It is a misdemeanor for any person:

7 ~~((1))~~ (a) To display or cause or permit to be displayed or have
8 in his or her possession any fictitious or fraudulently altered
9 driver's license or identicard;

10 ~~((2))~~ (b) To lend his or her driver's license or identicard to
11 any other person or knowingly permit the use thereof by another;

12 ~~((3))~~ (c) To display or represent as one's own any driver's
13 license or identicard not issued to him or her;

14 ~~((4))~~ (d) Willfully to fail or refuse to surrender to the
15 department upon its lawful demand any driver's license or identicard
16 which has been suspended, revoked or canceled;

1 ~~((+5))~~ (e) To use a false or fictitious name in any application
2 for a driver's license or identicard or to knowingly make a false
3 statement or to knowingly conceal a material fact or otherwise commit
4 a fraud in any such application;

5 ~~((+6))~~ (f) To permit any unlawful use of a driver's license or
6 identicard issued to him or her.

7 (2) It is a class C felony for any person to sell or deliver a
8 stolen driver's license or identicard.

9 (3) It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, sell, or deliver
10 a forged, fictitious, counterfeit, fraudulently altered, or unlawfully
11 issued driver's license or identicard, or to manufacture, sell, or
12 deliver a blank driver's license or identicard except under the
13 direction of the department. A violation of this subsection is:

14 (a) A class C felony if committed (i) for financial gain or (ii)
15 with intent to commit forgery, theft, or identity theft; or

16 (b) A gross misdemeanor if the conduct does not violate (a) of this
17 subsection.

18 (4) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, it is a
19 misdemeanor for any person under the age of twenty-one to manufacture
20 or deliver fewer than four forged, fictitious, counterfeit, or
21 fraudulently altered driver's licenses or identicards for the sole
22 purpose of misrepresenting a person's age.

23 (5) In a proceeding under subsection (2), (3), or (4) of this
24 section that is related to an identity theft under RCW 9.35.020, the
25 crime will be considered to have been committed in any locality where
26 the person whose means of identification or financial information was
27 appropriated resides, or in which any part of the offense took place,
28 regardless of whether the defendant was ever actually in that locality.
