Brief Description: Creating a youthful offender sentencing
alternative.

HB 1147-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Declares an offender is eligible for the youthful offender
sentencing alternative if: (1) The offender has been convicted in
adult criminal court pursuant to RCW 13.04.030(1)(e)(v) of any
charge other than murder in the first degree or murder in the
second degree, or an attempt to commit murder in the first or
second degree;

(2) The offender has no prior convictions for any serious
violent offense; and

(3) The offender has not previously been transferred to the
department of corrections from a facility for juveniles under RCW
13.40.280.
