HB 2322 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 2ND SUB)

Declares that the minimum standards must include, but not be limited to, the requirement that county, city, and state agencies administer psychological examinations and polygraph tests to persons applying for law enforcement personnel positions, including part-time positions and positions for reserve officers, with the county, city, or state agency.

Requires that, before a person may be appointed to act as a Washington state patrol officer, the person shall meet the minimum standards for employment with the Washington state patrol, including successful completion of a psychological examination and polygraph examination administered by the chief or his or her designee.
