1 On page 2, line 22, after "districts" insert ". The center's
2 role as a clearinghouse shall include establishing and maintaining
3 a website where parents, guardians, students, educators, and the
4 public may access information to help them navigate the public
5 school system in Washington. The center's website shall also
6 include links to the digital learning commons or other providers of
7 online courses and materials to assist students with remediation"

8 On page 2, beginning on line 39, strike all material through
9 "~~education~~" on line 8 and insert "~~((d))~~ (c) Develop ~~((and~~
10 ~~distribute, in conjunction with the academic achievement and~~
11 ~~accountability commission,))~~ parental involvement materials,
12 including instructional guides developed to inform parents of the
13 essential academic learning requirements required by the
14 superintendent of public instruction. The instructional guides
15 also shall contain actions parents may take to assist their
16 children in meeting the requirements, and should focus on reading
17 parents who have not previously been involved with their children's
18 education;"

19 Re-letter remaining subsection consecutively and correct any
20 internal references accordingly.

21 On page 4, on line 6, after "(5)" strike all material through
22 "system" on line 14 and insert the following:

23 "The director of the center for student learning shall report
24 to the Legislature by December 1, 2006 regarding:

25 (a) the steps taken to reactive the center for student
26 learning; and

27 (b) the director's plan for the center for student learning to
28 meet its statutory duties.

1 (6) The director of the center for student learning shall serve
2 on the Washington Learns advisory committee and shall participate
3 in the current study of Washington's education system being
4 conducted by Washington Learns."

5 Beginning on page 4, line 15, strike all of sections 3, 4, 5,
6 6, 7, and 8

7 Renummer remaining section consecutively and correct any
8 internal references accordingly.

9 On page 8, line 15, after "committee" strike all material
10 through "secretary"

11 On page 9, line 14, after "board of education" strike all
12 material through "state" on line 28

13 On page 10, after line 33, insert the following:

14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 15. If specific funding for the purposes of
15 this act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not
16 provided by June 30, 2006, in the omnibus appropriations act, this
17 act is null and void."

18 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Removes the creation of an education ombudsman's office. Requires the center for improvement of student learning to develop parental involvement materials. Requires the director of the center for improvement of student learning to serve on the Washington Learns advisory committee. Requires the director to report to the Legislature by December 1, 2006, regarding the center's reactivation and the director's plan for the center to meet its statutory duties. Requires the center to establish a website to provide information regarding the public school system in Washington, including links to the digital learning commons and other website that provide remediation courses to students. Provides that the superintendent of public instruction, although acting as an ex officio member of the advisory committee, will not serve as secretary to the committee. Adds a null and void clause.
