1 On page 9, beginning on line 7 of the amendment, after "credit."
2 strike all material through "districts." on line 9 and insert "However,
3 final decisions regarding (~~the awarding of high school credit~~)
4 whether credit meets the school district's graduation requirements
5 shall remain the responsibility of the school districts."

6 On page 19, after line 28 of the amendment, insert the following:

7 "Sec. 11. RCW 28A.250.050 and 2009 c 542 s 6 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 (1) By August 31, 2010, all school district boards of directors
10 shall develop policies and procedures regarding student access to
11 online courses and online learning programs. The policies and
12 procedures shall include but not be limited to: Student eligibility
13 criteria; the types of online courses available to students through the
14 school district; the methods districts will use to support student
15 success, which may include a local advisor; when the school district
16 will and will not pay course fees and other costs; the granting of high
17 school credit; and a process for students and parents or guardians to
18 formally acknowledge any course taken for which no credit is given.
19 The policies and procedures shall take effect beginning with the 2010-
20 11 school year. School districts shall submit their policies to the
21 superintendent of public instruction by September 15, 2010. By
22 December 1, 2010, the superintendent of public instruction shall
23 summarize the school district policies regarding student access to
24 online courses and submit a report to the legislature.

25 (2) School districts must award credit for online high school
26 courses successfully completed by a student that meet the school
27 district's graduation requirements and are provided by an approved
28 online provider.

1 (3) School districts shall provide students with information
2 regarding online courses that are available through the school
3 district. The information shall include the types of information
4 described in subsection (1) of this section.

5 (~~(3)~~) (4) When developing local or regional online learning
6 programs, school districts shall incorporate into the program design
7 the approval criteria developed by the superintendent of public
8 instruction under RCW 28A.250.020."

9 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
10 internal references accordingly.
