1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting certain registered sex offenders  
2 from entering school grounds; amending RCW 9A.44.190, 9A.44.193, and  
3 9A.44.196; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; adding a new section  
4 to chapter 9A.44 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing  
5 penalties.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.44.190 and 2006 c 126 s 4 are each amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 As used in this section and RCW 9A.44.193 and 9A.44.196:

10 (1) "Covered entity" means any public facility or private facility  
11 whose primary purpose, at any time, is to provide for the  
12 (~~education,~~) care(~~,~~) or recreation of a child or children,  
13 including but not limited to community and recreational centers,  
14 playgrounds, (~~schools,~~) swimming pools, and state or municipal parks.

15 (2) "Child" means a person under the age of eighteen, unless the  
16 context clearly indicates that the term is otherwise defined in  
17 statute.

18 (3) "Public facility" means a facility operated by a unit of local  
19 or state government, or by a nonprofit organization.

1 (4) "School(~~s~~)" means any public (~~and~~) or private school(~~s~~)  
2 that provides for the education or care of a child or children, but  
3 does not include home-based instruction as defined in RCW 28A.225.010.

4 (5) "Covered offender" means a person required to register under  
5 RCW 9A.44.130 who is eighteen years of age or older, who is not under  
6 the jurisdiction of the juvenile rehabilitation authority or currently  
7 serving a special sex offender disposition alternative(~~(, whose risk~~  
8 ~~level classification has been assessed at a risk level II or a risk~~  
9 ~~level III pursuant to RCW 72.09.345,)) and who, at any time, has been  
10 convicted of one or more of the following offenses:~~

11 (a) Rape of a child in the first, second, and third degree; child  
12 molestation in the first, second, and third degree; indecent liberties  
13 against a child under age fifteen; sexual misconduct with a minor in  
14 the first and second degree; incest in the first and second degree;  
15 luring with sexual motivation; possession of depictions of minors  
16 engaged in sexually explicit conduct; dealing in depictions of minors  
17 engaged in sexually explicit conduct; bringing into the state  
18 depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct; sexual  
19 exploitation of a minor; communicating with a minor for immoral  
20 purposes; (~~patronizing a juvenile prostitute~~) commercial sexual abuse  
21 of a minor; promoting commercial sexual abuse of a minor; promoting  
22 travel for commercial sexual abuse of a minor;

23 (b) Any felony in effect at any time prior to March 20, 2006, that  
24 is comparable to an offense listed in (a) of this subsection,  
25 including, but not limited to, statutory rape in the first and second  
26 (~~degrees [degree]~~) degree and carnal knowledge;

27 (c) Any felony offense for which:

28 (i) There was a finding that the offense was committed with sexual  
29 motivation; and

30 (ii) The victim of the offense was less than sixteen years of age  
31 at the time of the offense;

32 (d) An attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation to commit any of the  
33 offenses listed in (a) through (c) of this subsection;

34 (e) Any conviction from any other jurisdiction which is comparable  
35 to any of the offenses listed in (a) through (d) of this subsection.

36 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.44.193 and 2006 c 126 s 5 are each amended to read  
37 as follows:

1        (1)(a) A covered offender may not knowingly enter the legal  
2 premises of a school unless the offender has written permission as  
3 provided in subsection (3) of this section;

4        (b) If the covered offender enters the legal premises of a school  
5 without written permission, the offender may be charged and prosecuted  
6 for a felony offense as provided in RCW 9A.44.196;

7        (c) This subsection does not apply to a covered offender who is  
8 eighteen years of age and is attending or planning to attend the  
9 school.

10       (2) Except as provided in subsection (1) of this section, a covered  
11 offender may not enter the legal premises of a covered entity if an  
12 owner, manager, or operator of a covered entity (~~may~~) orders (~~a~~  
13 covered)) the offender from the legal premises of a covered entity as  
14 provided under this section. To do this, the owner, manager, or  
15 operator of a covered entity must first provide the covered offender,  
16 or cause the covered offender to be provided, personal service of a  
17 written notice that informs the covered offender that:

18        (a) The covered offender must leave the legal premises of the  
19 covered entity and may not return without the written permission of the  
20 covered entity; and

21        (b) If the covered offender refuses to leave the legal premises of  
22 the covered entity, or thereafter returns and enters within the legal  
23 premises of the covered entity without written permission, the offender  
24 may be charged and prosecuted for a felony offense as provided in RCW  
25 9A.44.196.

26       ~~((+2))~~ (3) A school under subsection (1) of this section or a  
27 covered entity under subsection (2) of this section may give written  
28 permission of entry and use to a covered offender to enter and remain  
29 on the legal premises of the covered entity at particular times and for  
30 lawful purposes, including, but not limited to, conducting business,  
31 voting, or participating in educational or recreational activities.  
32 Any written permission of entry and use of the legal premises of a  
33 covered entity must be clearly stated in a written document and must be  
34 personally served on the covered offender. If the covered offender  
35 violates the conditions of entry and use contained in a written  
36 document personally served on the offender by the school or covered  
37 entity, the covered offender may be charged and prosecuted for a felony  
38 offense as provided in RCW 9A.44.196.

1       (~~(3)~~) (4) An owner, employee, or agent of a school or covered  
2 entity shall be immune from civil liability for damages arising from  
3 excluding or failing to exclude a covered offender from a covered  
4 entity or from imposing or failing to impose conditions of entry and  
5 use on a covered offender.

6       (~~(4)~~) (5) A person provided with written notice from a covered  
7 entity under this section may file a petition with the district court  
8 alleging that he or she does not meet the definition of "covered  
9 offender" in RCW 9A.44.190. The district court must conduct a hearing  
10 on the petition within thirty days of the petition being filed. In the  
11 hearing on the petition, the person has the burden of proving that he  
12 or she is not a covered offender. If the court finds, by a  
13 preponderance of the evidence, that the person is not a covered  
14 offender, the court shall order the covered entity to rescind the  
15 written notice and shall order the covered entity to pay the person's  
16 costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.

17       **Sec. 3.** RCW 9A.44.196 and 2006 c 126 s 6 are each amended to read  
18 as follows:

19       (1) A person is guilty of the crime of criminal trespass against  
20 children if he or she:

21       (a) Is a covered offender as defined in RCW 9A.44.190; and

22       (b)(i) Enters the legal premises of a school without written  
23 permission as provided in RCW 9A.44.193;

24       (ii) Is personally served with written notice complying with the  
25 requirements of RCW 9A.44.193 that excludes the covered offender from  
26 the legal premises of the covered entity and remains upon or reenters  
27 the legal premises of the covered entity; or

28       (~~(ii)~~) (iii) Is personally served with written notice complying  
29 with the requirements of RCW 9A.44.193 that imposes conditions of entry  
30 and use on the covered offender and violates the conditions of entry  
31 and use.

32       (2) Criminal trespass against children is a class C felony.

33       NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW  
34 to read as follows:

35       A state or local agency that has an official designated by the  
36 agency for the purpose of registering offenders at the time of release

1 under RCW 9A.44.130 shall inform a covered offender at the time of  
2 release of the restrictions from entering school premises as provided  
3 in RCW 9A.44.193.

4 **Sec. 5.** RCW 9.94A.515 and 2010 c 289 s 11 and 2010 c 227 s 9 are
