2 an act of violence; and  
3       WHEREAS, The Dandelion Foundation resolves to work diligently to  
4 promote awareness and provide education and resources to persons  
5 affected by child abuse and domestic violence; and  
6       WHEREAS, The Dandelion Foundation works to prevent child abuse  
7 and family violence through education and awareness to all  
8 socioeconomic groups; and  
9       WHEREAS, The Dandelion Foundation provides education and support  
10 to those at risk for, experiencing, or surviving abuse; and  
11       WHEREAS, The Dandelion Foundation emphasizes that through these  
12 efforts, abuse can be prevented; and  
13       WHEREAS, The Dandelion Foundation strives to provide affected  
14 families a nonthreatening, judgment-free place to get help, and  
15 hopes, in the future, to provide a safe, secure environment for
