**Title:** An act relating to transportation funding and appropriations.

**Brief Description:** Making 2011-2013 supplemental transportation appropriations.

**Sponsors:** House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representatives Clibborn, Armstrong, Billig and Hargrove; by request of Governor Gregoire).

**Background:** The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium making various modifications to agency appropriations.

**Summary of Bill:** The 2011-13 biennial appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified.

**Appropriation:** Various.

**Fiscal Note:** Requested on March 6, 2012.
