1 AN ACT Relating to license fees under Title 77 RCW for veterans
2 with disabilities; amending RCW 77.32.480; and providing an effective
3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.480 and 2007 c 254 s 3 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) Upon written application, a combination fishing license shall
8 be issued at the reduced rate of five dollars(~~(7)~~) and all hunting
9 licenses shall(~~(7)~~) be issued at the reduced rate of a youth hunting
10 license fee for the following individuals:

11 ~~((1))~~ (a) A resident sixty-five years old or older who is an
12 honorably discharged veteran of the United States armed forces having
13 a service-connected disability;

14 ~~((2))~~ (b) A resident who is an honorably discharged veteran of
15 the United States armed forces with a thirty percent or more service-
16 connected disability;

17 ~~((3))~~ (c) A resident with a disability who permanently uses a
18 wheelchair;

19 ~~((4))~~ (d) A resident who is blind or visually impaired; and

1 (~~(5)~~) (e) A resident with a developmental disability as defined
2 in RCW 71A.10.020 with documentation of the disability certified by a
3 physician licensed to practice in this state.

4 (2) Upon department verification of eligibility, a nonstate
5 resident veteran with a disability who otherwise satisfies the criteria
6 of subsection (1)(a) and (b) of this section must be issued a
7 combination fishing license or any hunting license at the same cost
8 charged to a nondisabled Washington resident for the same license.

9 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act takes effect February 1, 2014.
