- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that an increase
- 8 in unemployment due to the declining timber economy in the state is
- 9 imminent. The legislature further recognizes that employment
- 10 opportunities in other natural resource management professions exist
- 11 and that natural resource enhancements in the areas of fisheries,
- 12 wildlife, and recreation can bring needed income to distressed local
- 13 economies in the state. It is the intent of the legislature that
- 14 dislocated timber workers be given training in and opportunities to
- 15 compete for employment in other resource management professions, and to
- 16 establish a pilot program in Skagit county to accomplish this
- 17 objective. The Skagit river represents a potential recreational
- 18 fishery that, if enhanced, will bring much needed income to Skagit
- 19 county. Enhancements to the fishery on the Skagit river are planned
- 20 over the next several years, and workers will be needed to fill these
- 21 positions. Displaced timber workers will be available to do this
- 22 work."
- 23 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Unless the context clearly requires
- 24 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 25 chapter.
- 26 (1) "Department" means the employment security department.
- 27 (2) "Dislocated timber worker" means any individual who:

- 1 (a) Has been terminated or received a notice of termination from
- 2 employment in a timber-related occupation within standard industrial
- 3 code 024; and
- 4 (b) At the time of last separation from employment, resided in or
- 5 was employed in a timber-dependent community.
- 6 (3) "College" means Skagit Valley Community College.
- 7 (4) "Local development agency" means the economic development
- 8 association of Skagit county."
- 9 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A pilot project shall be established,
- 10 coordinated jointly by the department and the college, in Skagit
- 11 county. The pilot project created in this section is subject to the
- 12 department and the college acquiring funds for the pilot project from
- 13 federal, state, or private sources. The project shall be of five years
- 14 duration."
- 15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The college shall develop a training
- 16 program designed for dislocated timber workers and their spouses, and
- 17 in doing so, shall:
- 18 (1) Consult with, at a minimum, the departments of natural
- 19 resources, ecology, wildlife, and fisheries, the parks and recreation
- 20 commission, and other state, federal, local, and private employers in
- 21 Skagit county to determine minimum employment qualifications in the
- 22 areas of natural resource management and enhancement of the Skagit
- 23 river; and
- 24 (2) Develop a program that will provide needed educational skills
- 25 to dislocated timber workers and their spouses."
- 26 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The department shall contract with the
- 27 local development agency to coordinate with the college and the

- 1 departments of wildlife, ecology, natural resources, and fisheries, the
- 2 parks and recreation commission, and other state, federal, local, and
- 3 private employers in assisting dislocated timber workers and their
- 4 spouses in securing education and employment in the natural resource
- 5 professions. The local development agency shall also provide
- 6 information on the training program established under section 4 of this
- 7 act."
- 8 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. The department and the college shall
- 9 jointly report to the legislature on their progress by November 1 of
- 10 each year, beginning in 1991 and ending November 1, 1996. This report
- 11 shall include a college program description, numbers of students,
- 12 numbers of referrals for existing positions by the local development
- 13 agency, and numbers of positions filled by dislocated timber workers."
- 14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. This act shall expire January 1, 1997."
- 15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 8. Sections 1 through 7 of this act shall
- 16 constitute a new chapter in Title 50 RCW."
- 17 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 9. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 18 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 19 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 20 effect July 15, 1991."
