6 recycling funding. The task force shall consist of fourteen members as
7 follows: (1) Two members of the house of representatives appointed by
8 the speaker of the house of representatives with one member from each
9 of the two caucuses of the house of representatives; (2) two members of
10 the senate appointed by the president of the senate with one member
11 from each of the two caucuses of the senate; (3) six members appointed
12 by the speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the
13 senate with one each representing manufacturers, wholesalers,
14 retailers, cities, counties, and an environmental organization; and (4)
15 three members representing the departments of ecology, trade and
16 economic development, and revenue appointed by their respective
17 directors.

18 The task force shall study long-term funding mechanisms for
19 recycling systems, comprehensive waste reduction, and diversion from
20 landfill and mass burn incineration. The task force shall report its
21 findings and recommended legislation to the appropriate standing
22 committees of the legislature no later than December 1, 1991.

23 The department of ecology shall provide administrative and staff
24 support to the task force. Members of the task force shall be
25 compensated in accordance with RCW 43.03.220. Nonlegislative members
26 shall receive subsistence and mileage in accordance with RCW 43.03.050

1 and 43.03.060. Legislative members shall receive allowances in
2 accordance with RCW 44.04.120.

3 This section shall expire January 1, 1992."
