6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the
8 rehabilitation process may be enhanced by participation in training,
9 education, and employment-related incentive programs and may be a
10 consideration in reducing time in confinement."

11 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 72.60 RCW
12 to read as follows:

13 (1) The department of corrections shall develop, in accordance with
14 RCW 72.09.010, a site-specific implementation plan for prison
15 industries space at Clallam Bay corrections center, McNeil Island
16 corrections center, and the one thousand twenty-four-bed medium
17 security prison as appropriated for and authorized by the legislature.

18 (2) Each implementation plan shall include, but not be limited to,
19 sufficient space and design elements that allow for: Meaningful and
20 productive class I, class II, and class IV employment opportunities;
21 educational opportunities; and incentives. The department shall
22 include in the implementation plans an incentive program based on
23 wages.

24 (3) The incentive program shall be developed so that inmates can
25 earn higher wages based on performance and production. Only those
26 inmates employed in class I and class II jobs may participate in the
27 incentive program. The department shall develop special program

1 criteria for inmates with physical or mental handicaps so that they can
2 participate in the incentive program.

3 (4) The department shall propose rules specifying that funds
4 recovered by the department from inmate wages, other than the amount an
5 inmate owes for taxes, legal financial obligations, and to the victim
6 restitution fund, shall be returned to the department to pay for the
7 cost of prison operations, including room and board, as defined by the
8 department.

9 (5) The plan shall identify actual or potential legal or
10 operational obstacles, or both, in implementing the components of the
11 plan as specified in this section, and recommend strategies to remove
12 the obstacles.

13 (6) The department shall submit the plan to the appropriate fiscal
14 committees of the legislature and to the governor by October 1, 1991."

15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. If any provision of this act or its
16 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
17 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
18 persons or circumstances is not affected."

19 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate
20 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
21 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
22 effect immediately."

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4 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "industries;" strike the
5 remainder of the title and insert "adding a new section to chapter
6 72.60 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency."
