- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that
- 8 maintenance and operation of a system of vital statistics and the
- 9 capturing of the cause of death for statistical and public health
- 10 purposes is essential to the interests of the state. "System of vital
- 11 statistics" means the registration, collection, preservation,
- 12 amendment, and certification of vital records; the collection of other
- 13 reports required by chapter 70.58 RCW; training activities related to
- 14 timely and accurate completion of vital records; and related
- 15 activities, including the tabulation, analysis, and publication of
- 16 vital statistics.
- 17 (2) The legislature further finds that the existing system hinders
- 18 the timely and accurate completion and filing of death certificates,
- 19 which causes hardships for bereaved families.
- 20 (3) In order to protect public health, achieve consistencies with
- 21 national standards for vital statistics systems, promote efficient
- 22 practices, and make use of available technologies, the legislature
- 23 recognizes that many antiquated laws and procedures developed over many
- 24 decades must be changed.
- 25 (4) The legislature recognizes it is necessary that the system be
- 26 maintained by the department of health in cooperation with appropriate
- 27 units of local government who have reporting requirements for births,
- 28 fetal deaths, deaths, marriages, and dissolutions."

- 1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) The vital statistics task force is
- 2 created, consisting of the secretary of health or a designee, the chair
- 3 of the house of representatives local government committee or a
- 4 designee, and the chair of the senate governmental operations committee
- 5 or a designee.
- 6 (2) The task force shall create a working group that includes
- 7 representatives of a broad range of affected interests, including
- 8 funeral service representatives, local health officers, local
- 9 registrars, research professionals, county coroners, county medical
- 10 examiners, hospital administrators, physicians, county officials, and
- 11 cemetery representatives. The working group shall provide information,
- 12 advice, and technical assistance to the task force. To the extent
- 13 possible, the members of the working group should be persons that have
- 14 been or are members of the center for health statistics advisory
- 15 committee.
- 16 (3) The task force shall report on its findings and recommendations
- 17 to the local government committee of the house of representatives and
- 18 the governmental operations committee of the senate by December 4,
- 19 1992. To complete the report, the department of health shall undertake
- 20 a review of the laws and procedures pertaining to vital statistics.
- 21 The report shall, at a minimum, address the following: Analysis of the
- 22 time restrictions placed on physicians and funeral directors, the
- 23 signing and filing of death certificates and by what method burial
- 24 transit permits are processed, who can issue permits and under what
- 25 circumstances, facilitating organ donation, timely disposition of
- 26 remains, and interstate transportation of the deceased."
