NEW SECTION. Sec. 701. The state board of education, in conjunction with the governor's council on education reform and funding, shall study the current requirements for the certification of teachers and administrators, and shall prepare a report to the legislature that includes options for improving the current The report, at a minimum, shall analyze certification system. postinitial certification requirements, including the continuing education, endorsement, and the fifth-year requirements, and shall analyze the merits of requiring teachers and administrators to develop personal education plans after they have obtained their initial certificates. The report shall be submitted to the appropriate committees of the house of representatives and senate by December 1, 1992."

((The state board of education shall develop and adopt rules establishing baccalaureate degree equivalency standards for certification of vocational instructors performing instructional duties and acquiring initial level certification after August 31, However, candidates for grades preschool through eight 1992.)) certificates shall have fulfilled the requirements for a major as part of their baccalaureate degree. If the major is in early childhood education, elementary education, or special education, the candidate must have at least thirty quarter hours or twenty semester hours in one academic field.

(((2) The state board of education shall study the impact of eliminating the major in education under subsection (1) of this section and submit a report to the legislature by January 15, 1990. The report shall include a recommendation on whether the major in education under subsection (1) of this section should be eliminated.

- (4) Certificate holders may renew the certificate for a threeyear period by providing proof of acceptance and enrollment in an approved masters degree program. A second renewal, for a period of
