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- 5 On page 8, beginning on line 4 of the amendment, after
- 6 "commission." strike all language through "business." on line 26, and
- 7 insert "The commission shall consist of thirteen members appointed by
- 8 the governor with the consent of the senate. One member other than the
- 9 administrator of the Washington health care authority shall be
- 10 designated by the governor as chair. In appointing members, the
- 11 governor shall ensure that:
- 12 (a) Three of the members represent health service providers, one
- 13 of whom shall represent physicians, one of whom shall represent
- 14 hospitals, and one of whom shall represent all other health service
- 15 providers;
- 16 (b) Three of the members represent insurance carriers, one of whom
- 17 shall represent disability insurers, one of whom shall represent health
- 18 care service contractors, and one of whom shall represent health
- 19 maintenance organizations;
- 20 (c) Two of the members represent health service purchasers, one of
- 21 whom shall represent large employers, and one of whom shall represent
- 22 small employers;
- 23 (d) Four of the members represent the public, two of whom shall
- 24 represent health service consumers, one of whom shall represent local
- 25 public health departments, and one of whom shall represent employee
- 26 organizations; and
- (e) One member shall be the administrator of the Washington health
- 28 care authority, or his or her designee.

- 1 Members shall serve four-year terms. Of the initial members
- 2 appointed to the council, four shall serve for two years, four shall
- 3 serve for three years, and four shall serve for four years. Thereafter
- 4 members shall be appointed to four-year terms. Vacancies shall be
- 5 filled by appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term of the
- 6 position being vacated.
- 7 (3) The chair of the council shall serve at the pleasure of the
- 8 governor and shall be a full-time employee. The chair shall be exempt
- 9 from the provisions of chapter 41.06 RCW, and shall be paid a salary to
- 10 be fixed by the governor in accordance with RCW 43.03.040.
- 11 (4) The members, exclusive of the chair, shall be compensated as
- 12 provided in RCW 43.03.250. The members, exclusive of the chair, shall
- 13 be reimbursed for travel expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and
- 14 43.03.060.
- 15 (5) A majority of the members of the commission constitutes a
- 16 quorum for the conduct of business."
