3 On page 2, after line 13, insert the following:

4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. By December 1, 1991, the  
5 superintendent of public instruction shall review the current use  
6 of aides on special education buses and provide to the education  
7 committees of the house of representatives and the senate  
8 recommended guidelines, with associated fiscal impacts, for  
9 increasing the use of aides on special education buses.

10 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The superintendent of public  
11 instruction, in cooperation with school districts, the state  
12 patrol, and local law enforcement personnel, shall develop a  
13 proposed definition and guidelines for implementing an expanded  
14 definition of "hazardous walking conditions" as used in RCW  
15 28A.160.160(4) that would also include "social hazards." At a  
16 minimum, social hazards shall include areas with unacceptable  
17 levels of narcotic activity, sex offenders, prostitution, street  
18 violence, or environmentally dangerous conditions such as toxic  
19 waste dumps. The superintendent of public instruction shall submit  
20 its proposed definition and guidelines, with the projected fiscal  
21 impact of implementing the definition and guidelines, to the

1 education committees of the house of representatives and the senate  
2 by December 1, 1991."

3 Renumber the remaining section and correct internal references  
4 accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires that SPI review the increased use of aides on special education buses, and review whether the criteria used for defining "hazardous walking conditions" should be expanded.
