- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes the unique
- 8 legal risks that foster parents face in taking children into their
- 9 care. Third parties have filed claims against foster parents for
- 10 losses and damage caused by foster children. Additionally, foster
- 11 children and their parents have sued foster parents for actions
- 12 occurring while the children were in foster care. The legislature
- 13 finds that some potential foster parents are unwilling to subject
- 14 themselves to potential liability without insurance protection. The
- 15 legislature further finds that to encourage those people to serve as
- 16 foster parents, it is necessary to assure that such insurance is
- 17 available to them."
- 18 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 74.14B
- 19 RCW to read as follows:
- 20 (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, the secretary of
- 21 social and health services shall provide liability insurance to foster
- 22 parents licensed under chapter 74.15 RCW. The coverage shall be for
- 23 personal injury and property damage caused by foster parents or foster
- 24 children that occurred while the children were in foster care. Such
- 25 insurance shall cover acts of ordinary negligence but shall not cover
- 26 illegal conduct or bad faith acts taken by foster parents in providing
- 27 foster care. Moneys paid from liability insurance for any claim are

- 1 limited to the amount by which the claim exceeds the amount available
- 2 to the claimant from any valid and collectible liability insurance.
- 3 (2) The secretary of social and health services may purchase the
- 4 insurance required in subsection (1) of this section or may choose a
- 5 self-insurance method. The total moneys expended pursuant to this
- 6 authorization shall not exceed five hundred thousand dollars per
- 7 biennium. If the secretary elects a method of self-insurance, the
- 8 expenditure shall include all administrative and staff costs. If the
- 9 secretary elects a method of self-insurance, he or she may, by rule,
- 10 place a limit on the maximum amount to be paid on each claim.
- 11 (3) Nothing in this section or section 3 of this act is intended to
- 12 modify the foster parent reimbursement plan in place on the effective
- 13 date of this act.
- 14 (4) The liability insurance program shall be available by July 1,
- 15 1991."
- 16 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 In actions for personal injury or property damage commenced by
- 19 foster children or their parents against foster parents licensed
- 20 pursuant to chapter 74.15 RCW, the liability of foster parents for the
- 21 care and supervision of foster children shall be the same as the
- 22 liability of biological and adoptive parents for the care and
- 23 supervision of their children."
- 24 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. If specific funding for the purposes of
- 25 this act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June
- 26 30, 1991, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and
- 27 void."

- 1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 4 effect July 1, 1991."
