EFFECT: Removes the requirement that the Department of Fisheries pursue all available options to gain authority from the National Marine Fisheries Service to take marine mammals, and instead requires the Department of Fisheries to support the Department of Wildlife in its efforts to gain authority to take marine mammals. Replaces the requirement that the Department of Wildlife pursue all available options for lethal removal with a requirement that the Department pursue all available options for taking, which includes harassment, hunting, capture, or killing. Constrains the required actions by the Department of Wildlife to situations in which escapement goals for anadromous fish are not being met due to marine mammal predation.
