- 5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the

- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that some stocks
- 8 of Skagit river salmon are declining, and that no recovery plan exists
- 9 for these stocks. The legislature declares that the recovery and
- 10 enhancement of Skagit river salmon should receive high priority since
- 11 the status of these stocks affects the ocean fishery as well as the
- 12 fishery on the Skagit river. The legislature further finds that
- 13 dislocated timber workers represent a potential work force to conduct
- 14 salmon enhancement projects, if adequate training is provided in the
- 15 area of fish management to these dislocated workers, and if sufficient
- 16 coordination exists between potential employers and employees."
- 17 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The director of fisheries shall prepare
- 18 a salmon recovery plan for the Skagit river. The plan shall
- 19 incorporate the best available technology in order to achieve maximum
- 20 restoration of depressed salmon stocks. The utilization of salmon
- 21 hatchery programs must be an important component of the recovery plan.
- 22 The plan must encourage the restoration of natural spawning areas and
- 23 natural rearing of salmon but must not preclude the development of an
- 24 active hatchery program."
- 25 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The director shall present the recovery
- 26 plan to the legislature on or before December 31, 1991. The plan shall

- 1 include funding requirements for salmon hatchery programs and natural
- 2 spawning programs."
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Unless the context clearly requires
- 4 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 5 chapter.
- 6 (1) "Dislocated timber worker" means any individual who:
- 7 (a) Has been terminated or received a notice of termination from
- 8 employment in a timber-related occupation within standard industrial
- 9 code 024; and
- 10 (b) At the time of last separation from employment, resided in or
- 11 was employed in a timber-dependent community.
- 12 (2) "College" means Skagit Valley Community College.
- 13 (3) "Local development agency" means the economic development
- 14 association of Skagit county."
- 15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A pilot project shall be established,
- 16 coordinated jointly by the department and the college, in Skagit
- 17 county. The pilot project created in this section is subject to the
- 18 department and the college acquiring funds for the pilot project from
- 19 federal, state, or private sources. The project shall be of five years
- 20 duration."
- 21 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. The college shall develop a training
- 22 program designed for dislocated timber workers and their spouses, and
- 23 in doing so, shall:
- 24 (1) Consult with, at a minimum, the departments of natural
- 25 resources, ecology, wildlife, and fisheries, the parks and recreation
- 26 commission, and other state, federal, local, and private employers in
- 27 Skagit county to determine minimum employment qualifications in the

- 1 areas of natural resource management and enhancement of the Skagit
- 2 river salmon; and
- 3 (2) Develop a program that will provide needed educational skills
- 4 to dislocated timber workers and their spouses."
- 5 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. The employment security department shall
- 6 contract with the local development agency to coordinate with the
- 7 college and the departments of wildlife, ecology, natural resources,
- 8 and fisheries, the parks and recreation commission, and other state,
- 9 federal, local, and private employers in assisting dislocated timber
- 10 workers and their spouses in securing education and employment in the
- 11 natural resource professions. The local development agency shall also
- 12 provide information on the training program established under section
- 13 6 of this act."
- 14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 8. The employment security department and
- 15 the college shall jointly report to the legislature on their progress
- 16 by November 1 of each year, beginning in 1991 and ending November 1,
- 17 1996. This report shall include a college program description, numbers
- 18 of students, numbers of referrals for existing positions by the local
- 19 development agency, and numbers of positions filled by dislocated
- 20 timber workers."
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 9. The employment security department,
- 22 subject to the availability of funding under section 10 of this act or
- 23 an appropriation from the general fund, shall establish the pilot
- 24 natural resource worker project. The project shall be located in
- 25 Skagit county, shall terminate on July 1, 1996, and shall provide
- 26 employment and training opportunities for dislocated timber workers in
- 27 the areas of fisheries, wildlife, recreation, and other natural

- 1 resource professions. The department of personnel shall approve the
- 2 project. The goal of the project is to allow project employees to be,
- 3 upon termination of their participation in the project, eligible for
- 4 permanent employment relating to enhancement of Skagit river salmon
- 5 with the departments of wildlife, fisheries, ecology, and natural
- 6 resources, and the parks and recreation commission."
- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 10. The employment security department shall
- 8 use federal funds that it receives for dislocated timber workers to
- 9 contract with the departments of wildlife, fisheries, ecology, and
- 10 natural resources, and the parks and recreation commission to hire
- 11 natural resource worker project participants to conduct tasks in the
- 12 areas of fisheries, wildlife, forestry, ecology, and recreation,
- 13 particularly in the area of Skagit river salmon enhancement."
- 14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 11. The natural resource worker project
- 15 shall include the following elements:
- 16 (1) Recruitment of dislocated timber workers;
- 17 (2) Placement in the departments of wildlife, fisheries, ecology,
- 18 and natural resources, and the parks and recreation commission;
- 19 (3) On-the-job training in entry-level natural resource management
- 20 skills;
- 21 (4) Comparable salaries and benefits to entry-level positions
- 22 already existing in the departments of wildlife, fisheries, ecology,
- 23 and natural resources, and the parks and recreation commission."
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 12. The employment security department,
- 25 along with the departments of personnel, wildlife, fisheries, ecology,
- 26 and natural resources, and the parks and recreation commission shall
- 27 report annually to the legislature on November 1 of each year beginning

- 1 November 1, 1992, and until November 1, 1995, on the natural resource
- 2 worker project.
- 3 The report shall include, at a minimum, the following elements:
- 4 (1) The number of project employees;
- 5 (2) The number and description of positions filled, by agency;
- 6 (3) Training received;
- 7 (4) Duration of employment; and
- 8 (5) Placement in permanent positions."
- 9 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 13. This act shall expire January 1, 1997."
- 10 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 14. Sections 4 through 13 of this act shall
- 11 constitute a new chapter in Title 50 RCW."
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 15. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 14 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 15 effect July 15, 1991."
