- 1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2 A new section is added to chapter 70.94
- 2 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 (1) Any county that is part of a multicounty authority,
- 4 pursuant to RCW 70.94.053, may withdraw from the multicounty
- 5 authority after January 1, 1992, if the county wishes to provide
- 6 for air quality protection and regulation by an alternate air
- 7 quality authority. A withdrawing county shall:
- 8 (a) Create its own single county authority;
- 9 (b) Join another existing multicounty authority with which its
- 10 boundaries are contiguous;
- 11 (c) Join with one or more contiguous inactive authorities to
- 12 operate as a new multicounty authority; or
- 13 (d) Become an inactive authority and subject to regulation by
- 14 the department of ecology.
- 15 (2) In order to withdraw from an existing multicounty
- 16 authority, a county shall make arrangements, by inter-local
- 17 agreement, for division of assets and liabilities and the
- 18 appropriate release of any and all interest in assets of the
- 19 multicounty authority.
- 20 (3) In order to effectuate any of the alternate arrangements

- 1 in subsection (1) of this section, the procedures of this chapter
- 2 to create an air pollution control authority shall be met and the
- 3 actions must be taken at least six months prior to the effective
- 4 date of withdrawal. The rules of the original multicounty
- 5 authority shall continue in force for the withdrawing county until
- 6 such time as all conditions to create an air pollution control
- 7 authority have been met.
- 8 (4) At the effective date of a county's withdrawal, the
- 9 remaining counties shall reorganize and reconstitute the
- 10 legislative authority pursuant to this chapter. The air pollution
- 11 control regulations of the existing multicounty authority shall
- 12 remain in force and effect after the reorganization.
- 13 (5) If a county elects to withdraw from an existing
- 14 multicounty authority, the air pollution control regulations shall
- 15 remain in effect for the withdrawing county until suspended by the
- 16 adoption of rules, regulations, or ordinances adopted under one of
- 17 the alternatives of subsection (1) of this section. A county shall
- 18 initiate proceedings to adopt such rules, regulations, or
- 19 ordinances on or before the effective date of the county's
- 20 withdrawal."

EFFECT: Specifies a mechanism for a county to withdraw from a multicounty air pollution control authority without requiring a majority vote of the governing body of the multicounty authority.
