- 30 (e) Polishing and smoothing restorations;

- 1 (f) Oral prophylaxis and removal of deposits and stains from the
- 2 surface of the teeth;
- 3 (g) Recording health histories;
- 4 (h) Taking and recording blood pressure and vital signs;
- 5 (i) Performing subgingival and supragingival scaling; and
- 6 (j) Root planing.
- 7 (4) A person practicing with a temporary license granted under this
- 8 section may not perform the following dental hygiene procedures:
- 9 (a) Give injections of local anesthetic or administer nitrous
- 10 oxide/oxygen analgesia;
- 11 (b) Place restorations into the cavity prepared by a licensed
- 12 dentist and afterwards carve, contour, and adjust contacts and
