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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28A.630.140 and 1988 c 1 s 1 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

9 Initial applications to participate in the schools for the twenty-
10 first century pilot program shall be submitted by the school district
11 board of directors to the state board of education not later than May
12 31, 1988. Subject to available funding, additional applications may be
13 submitted for board consideration by November 1 of subsequent years.
14 Each application shall contain a proposed plan which:

15 (1) Enumerates specific activities to be carried out as part of the
16 pilot school(s) project;

17 (2) Commits all parties to work cooperatively during the term of
18 the pilot project;

19 (3) Includes provisions for some or all certificated school staff,
20 including certificated administrative staff, and classified school
21 employees whose primary duties are the daily educational instruction of
22 students, to be employed on supplemental contracts with additional
23 compensation for a minimum of an average of ten additional days beyond
24 the general state funded school year allocations for the participating
25 employees, and staff development time as provided by legislative
26 appropriation, and, notwithstanding (~~the provisions of RCW~~
27 ~~28A.58.095(1))~~) RCW 28A.400.200, district resources may be used to fund

1 the employment of staff beyond the average of ten additional days for
2 the purposes of the pilot project;

3 (4) Includes budget plans for the project and additional
4 anticipated sources of funding, including private grants and
5 contributions, if any;

6 (5) Identifies the technical resources desired, the potential costs
7 of those resources, and the institutions of higher education,
8 educational service districts, or consultants available to provide such
9 services;

10 (6) Identifies the evaluation and accountability processes to be
11 used to measure school-wide student and project performance, and
12 identifies a model which provides the basis for a staff incentive pay
13 system. Implementation of the staff incentive pay system is not
14 required;

15 (7) Justifies each request for waiver of specific state statutes or
16 administrative rules during at least the first two years of the
17 project;

18 (8) Includes a written statement that school directors and
19 administrators are willing to exempt the pilot school(s) from
20 specifically identified local rules, as needed;

21 (9) Includes a written statement that the school directors and the
22 local bargaining agents will modify those portions of their local
23 agreements as applicable for the pilot school(s) project; and

24 (10) Includes written statements of support from the district's
25 board of directors, the district superintendent, the principal and
26 staff of the building requesting to become a pilot school; and
27 statements of support, willingness to participate, or concerns from any
28 interested parent, business, or community organization."

1 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.630

2 RCW to read as follows:

3 (1) The state board of education shall submit by January 15, 1995,
4 to the legislature and the governor, a final report on the schools for
5 the twenty-first century program. This report shall include but is not
6 limited to the following information:

7 (a) Improvements in student performance resulting from activities
8 carried out under the schools for the twenty-first century program;

9 (b) The relationship between improvements in student performance
10 and increasing local decision-making authority under the schools for
11 the twenty-first century program; and

12 (c) Identification of restructuring that occurred with and without
13 the granting of waivers of state statutes or administrative rules.

14 (2) The state board of education and the superintendent of public
15 instruction, from available funds, may contract for an independent
16 evaluation of the schools for the twenty-first century program.

17 (3) This section shall expire January 30, 1995."
