- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.05 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (1)(a) The legislature finds that the rate of infant mortality in
- 10 Washington state is unacceptably high, and that such mortality may be
- 11 preventable. The legislature further finds that, through the
- 12 performance of infant mortality reviews, preventable causes of infant
- 13 mortality can be identified and addressed, thereby reducing the rate of
- 14 infant mortality in Washington state.
- 15 (b) It is the intent of the legislature to encourage the
- 16 performance of infant death reviews by local health departments by
- 17 providing necessary legal protections to the families of infants whose
- 18 deaths are studied, local health department officials and employees,
- 19 and health care professionals participating in infant mortality review
- 20 committee activities.
- 21 (2) As used in this section, "infant mortality review" means a
- 22 process authorized by a local health department as such department is
- 23 defined in RCW 70.05.010 for examining factors that contribute to
- 24 infant death through a systematic review of medical, clinical, and
- 25 hospital records; home interviews of parents and caretakers of infants
- 26 who have died; analysis of individual case information; and review of
- 27 this information by a team of professionals in order to identify
- 28 modifiable medical, socioeconomic, public health, behavioral,

- 1 administrative, educational, and environmental factors associated with
- 2 each death.
- 3 (3) Local health departments are authorized to conduct infant
- 4 mortality reviews. In conducting such reviews, the following
- 5 provisions shall apply:
- 6 (a) All medical records, reports, and statements procured by,
- 7 furnished to, or maintained by a local health department pursuant to
- 8 chapter 70.02 RCW for purposes of an infant mortality review are
- 9 confidential insofar as the identity of an individual infant and his or
- 10 her adoptive or natural parents is concerned. Such records may be used
- 11 solely by local health departments for the purposes of the review. This
- 12 section does not prevent a local health department from publishing
- 13 statistical compilations and reports related to the infant mortality
- 14 review, if such compilations and reports do not identify individual
- 15 cases and sources of information.
- 16 (b) Any records or documents supplied or maintained for the
- 17 purposes of an infant mortality review are not subject to discovery or
- 18 subpoena in any administrative, civil, or criminal proceeding related
- 19 to the death of an infant reviewed. This provision shall not restrict
- 20 or limit the discovery or subpoena from a health care provider of
- 21 records or documents maintained by such health care provider in the
- 22 ordinary course of business, whether or not such records or documents
- 23 may have been supplied to a local health department pursuant to this
- 24 section.
- 25 (c) Any summaries or analyses of records, documents, or records of
- 26 interviews prepared exclusively for purposes of an infant mortality
- 27 review are not subject to discovery, subpoena, or introduction into

- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 42.17 RCW

- Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 42.17.250 through 42.17.340,
- 14 no local health department may be required under this chapter to make
- 15 available for public inspection or copying any records or documents
- 16 obtained, prepared, or maintained by the local health department for
- 17 the purposes of an infant mortality review conducted by the department
- 18 pursuant to section 1 of this act. This section shall not apply to
- 19 published statistical compilations and reports relating to the infant
- 20 mortality review studies that do not identify individual cases and
- 21 sources of information."
