22 RCW 28A.305.130 (1) and (2). (~~The state board of education shall~~
23 ~~develop and adopt rules establishing baccalaureate degree equivalency~~
24 ~~standards for certification of vocational instructors performing~~

3 eight certificates shall have fulfilled the requirements for a major as

18 ~~and if the certificate holder can demonstrate substantial progress~~
