If the boundaries described in the petition for the 8 9 formation of a public hospital district are changed prior to the 10 election on the proposition for the formation of the public hospital district, then the auditor of the county in which the public hospital 11 district is located or, if the public hospital district encompasses 12 portions of more than one county, the auditor of the county in which 13 14 the largest portion of the public hospital district is located shall redetermine the boundaries of the commissioner districts in accordance 15 with the above provisions. Any candidate for a particular public 16 17 hospital district commissioner district position must be a registered voter of that commissioner district. Public hospital district 18 19 commissioners shall hold office for the term of six years and until 20 their successors are elected and qualified, each term to commence on the first day in January following the election. At the election at 21 which the proposition is submitted to the voters as to whether a 22 district shall be formed, three commissioners shall be elected to hold 23 24 office, respectively, for the terms of two, four, and six years. All 25 candidates shall be voted upon by the entire district, and the 26 candidate residing in commissioner district No. 1 receiving the highest 27 number of votes in the hospital district shall hold office for the term 28 of six years; the candidate residing in commissioner district No. 2 29 receiving the highest number of votes in the hospital district shall hold office for the term of four years; and the candidate residing in 30

commissioner district No. 3 receiving the highest number of votes in 1 2 the hospital district shall hold office for the term of two years. The 3 first commissioners to be elected shall take office immediately when 4 qualified in accordance with RCW 29.01.135. Each term of the initial commissioners shall date from the time above specified following the 5 6 organizational election, but shall also include the period intervening between the organizational election and the first day of January 7 following the next district general election: PROVIDED, That in public 8 9 hospital districts ((encompassing portions of more than one county, the total vote cast upon the proposition to form the district shall exceed 10 11 forty percent of the total number of votes cast in each portion of each county lying within the proposed district at the next preceding general 12 13 county election. The portion of the proposed district located within 14 each county shall constitute a separate commissioner district. There 15 shall be three district commissioners whose terms shall be six years. 16 Each district shall be designated by the name of the county in which it 17 is located.
