- An election shall be held in the area proposed to be incorporated to determine whether the proposed city or town shall be incorporated if the boundary review board approves or modifies and approves the proposal, or if the county legislative authority does not disapprove the proposal as provided in RCW 35.02.070. Voters at this election
- 14 The initial election on the question of incorporation shall be held 15 at the next special election date specified in RCW 29.13.020 that occurs sixty or more days after the final public hearing by the county 16 legislative authority or authorities, or the approval or modification 17 18 and approval by the boundary review board or boards. The county legislative authority or authorities shall call for this election and, 19 20 if the incorporation is approved, shall call for other elections to 21 elect the elected officials as provided in this section. If the vote in favor of the incorporation receives ((forty)) thirty percent or less 22 23 of the total vote on the question of incorporation, no new election on 24 the question of incorporation for the area or any portion of the area 25 proposed to be incorporated may be held for a period of three years 26 from the date of the election in which the incorporation failed. This three-year prohibition shall not apply to any proposed city or town in 27 which such election was held after September 1, 1990, but before the 28

- If the incorporation is authorized as provided by RCW 35.02.120,
