7 "Sec. 40. RCW 18.92.015 and 1991 c 3 s 238 are each amended
8 to read as follows:

9 (~~The term~~) Unless the context clearly requires otherwise,
10 the definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter.

11 "Animal technician" means a person who has successfully
12 completed an examination administered by the board and who has
13 either successfully completed a post high school course approved by
14 the board in the care and treatment of animals or had five years'
15 practical experience, acceptable to the board, with a licensed
16 veterinarian.

17 "Board" (~~used in this chapter shall~~) means the Washington
18 state veterinary board of governors(~~and the term "secretary"~~
19 ~~shall~~)).

20 "Department" means the department of health.

21 "Secretary" means the secretary of (~~health of the state of~~
22 ~~Washington~~) the department of health.

23 (~~"Animal technician" shall mean a person who has successfully~~
24 ~~completed an examination administered by the board and who has~~
25 ~~either successfully completed a post high school course approved by~~

1 ~~the board in the care and treatment of animals, or a person who has~~
2 ~~had five years practical experience acceptable to the board with a~~
3 ~~licensed veterinarian.))"~~

4 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 41.** A new section is added to chapter
5 18.92 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) The department may issue a license to practice specialized
7 veterinary medicine in this state to a veterinarian who:

8 (a) Submits an application on a form provided by the secretary
9 for a license in a specialty area recognized by the board by rule;

10 (b) Holds a current certification as a diplomate of a national
11 specialty board or college recognized by the board by rule in the
12 specialty area for which application is submitted;

13 (c) Is not subject to license investigation, suspension,
14 revocation, or other disciplinary action in any state, United
15 States territory, or province of Canada;

16 (d) Has successfully completed an examination established by
17 the board regarding this state's laws and rules regulating the
18 practice of veterinary medicine; and

19 (e) Provides other information and verification required by
20 the board.

21 (2) A veterinarian licensed to practice specialized veterinary
22 medicine shall not practice outside his or her licensed specialty
23 unless he or she meets licensing requirements established for
24 practicing veterinary medicine, surgery, and dentistry under RCW
25 18.92.070 and 18.92.100.

1 (3) The board shall determine by rule the limits of the
2 practice of veterinary medicine, surgery, and dentistry represented
3 by a license to practice specialized veterinary medicine.

4 (4) The board may deny, revoke, suspend, or modify a license
5 to practice specialized veterinary medicine if the national
6 specialty board or college certifying the licensee denies, revokes,
7 suspends, modifies, withdraws, or otherwise limits the
8 certification or if the certification expires."

9 "Sec. 42. RCW 18.92.145 and 1991 c 3 s 248 are each amended
10 to read as follows:

11 The secretary shall determine the fees, as provided in RCW
12 43.70.250, for the issuance, renewal, or administration of the
13 following licenses, certificates of registration, permits,
14 duplicate licenses, renewals, or examination:

15 (1) For a license to practice veterinary medicine, surgery,
16 and dentistry issued upon an examination given by the examining
17 board;

18 (2) For a license to practice veterinary medicine, surgery,
19 and dentistry issued upon the basis of a license issued in another
20 state;

21 (3) For a certificate of registration as an animal technician;

22 (4) For a temporary permit to practice veterinary medicine,
23 surgery, and dentistry. The temporary permit fee shall be
24 accompanied by the full amount of the examination fee;

25 (5) For a license to practice specialized veterinary

1 medicine."

8 of sections 42 and 43 and insert the following:

9 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 42.** If specific funding for the
10 purposes of sections 1 through 39 of this act, referencing this act
11 by bill number, is not provided by June 30, 1991, in the omnibus
12 appropriations act, sections 1 through 39 of this act shall be null
13 and void."

14 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 43.** Nothing in sections 1 through 39
15 of this act is intended to change the scope of practice of any
16 health care profession referred to in sections 1 through 39 of this
17 act."
