- 7 "Sec. 1. RCW 53.04.020 and 1990 c 259 s 15 are each amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 At any general election or at any special election which may be
- 10 called for that purpose, the county legislative authority of any county
- 11 in this state may, or on petition of ten percent of the registered
- 12 voters of such county based on the total vote cast in the last general
- 13 county election, shall, by resolution submit to the voters of such
- 14 county the proposition of creating a port district ((which may: (1)
- 15 Be)) coextensive with the limits of such county ((as now or hereafter
- 16 established; or (2) be under the provisions of RCW 53.04.022)). Such
- 17 petition shall be filed with the county auditor, who shall within
- 18 fifteen days examine the signatures thereof and certify to the
- 19 sufficiency or insufficiency thereof, and for such purpose the county
- 20 auditor shall have access to all registration books in the possession
- 21 of the officers of any incorporated city or town in such proposed port
- 22 district. If such petition be found to be insufficient, it shall be
- 23 returned to the persons filing the same, who may amend or add names
- 24 thereto for ten days, when the same shall be returned to the county
- 25 auditor, who shall have an additional fifteen days to examine the same
- 26 and attach his or her certificate thereto. No person having signed
- 27 such petition shall be allowed to withdraw his or her name therefrom
- 28 after the filing of the same with the county auditor. Whenever such

- 1 petition shall be certified to as sufficient, the county auditor shall
- 2 forthwith transmit the same, together with his or her certificate of
- 3 sufficiency attached thereto, to the legislative authority of the
- 4 county, who shall submit such proposition at the next general election
- 5 or, if such petition so requests, the county legislative authority
- 6 shall, at their first meeting after the date of such certificate, by
- 7 resolution, call a special election to be held in accordance with RCW
- 8 29.13.010 and 29.13.020. The notice of election shall state the
- 9 boundaries of the proposed port district and the object of such
- 10 election. In submitting the question to the voters for their approval
- 11 or rejection, the proposition shall be expressed on the ballot
- 12 substantially in the following terms:
- "Port of ...... Yes." (giving the name of the principal
- 14 seaport city within such proposed port district, or if there be more
- 15 than one city of the same class within such district, such name as may
- 16 be determined by the legislative authority of the county).
- 17 "Port of ....., No." (giving the name of the principal seaport
- 18 city within such port district, or if there be more than one city of
- 19 the same class within such district, such name as may be determined by
- 20 the legislative authority of the county)."
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 53.04 RCW
- 22 to read as follows:
- 23 A less than county-wide port district with an assessed valuation of
- 24 at least seventy-five million dollars may be created in a county that
- 25 already has a less than county-wide port district located within its
- 26 boundaries. Except as provided in this section, such a port district
- 27 shall be created in accordance with the procedure to create a county-
- 28 wide port district.

- 1 The effort to create such a port district is initiated by the
- 2 filing of a petition with the county auditor calling for the creation
- 3 of such a port district, describing the boundaries of the proposed port
- 4 district, and providing a name for the proposed port district. The
- 5 petition must be signed by voters residing within the proposed port
- 6 district equal in number to at least ten percent of such voters who
- 7 voted at the last county general election.
- 8 A public hearing on creation of the proposed port district shall be
- 9 held by the county legislative authority if the county auditor
- 10 certifies that the petition contained sufficient valid signatures.
- 11 Notice of the public hearing must be published in the county's official
- 12 newspaper at least ten days prior to the date of the public hearing.
- 13 After taking testimony, the county legislative authority may make
- 14 changes in the boundaries of the proposed port district if it finds
- 15 that such changes are in the public interest and shall determine if the
- 16 creation of the port district is in the public interest. No area may
- 17 be added to the boundaries unless a subsequent public hearing is held
- 18 on the proposed port district.
- 19 The county legislative authority shall submit a ballot proposition
- 20 authorizing the creation of the proposed port district to the voters of
- 21 the proposed port district, at any special election date provided in
- 22 RCW 29.13.020, if it finds the creation of the port district to be in
- 23 the public interest.
- 24 The port district shall be created if a majority of the voters
- 25 voting on the ballot proposition favor the creation of the port
- 26 district. The initial port commissioners shall be elected at the same
- 27 election as provided in RCW 53.12.050, but the election of
- 28 commissioners shall be null and void if the port district is not
- 29 created. Commissioner districts shall not be used in the initial
- 30 election of the port commissioners."

- 1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 53.04 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 A port district that is less than county-wide may annex adjacently
- 4 located territory that is located in another less than county-wide port
- 5 district in the same county, if the territory proposed to be annexed is
- 6 located in a city the name of which is included as part of the name of
- 7 the annexing port district. A port district proposing to annex
- 8 territory under this section shall by resolution cause a ballot
- 9 proposition on the issue of annexation to be submitted to the voters of
- 10 the area proposed to be annexed. The annexation is authorized when the
- 11 ballot proposition is approved of by over fifty percent of the ballots
- 12 cast. The territory that is annexed shall be removed from the other
- 13 port district.
- 14 This section shall expire January 1, 1995."
- 15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. If any provision of this act or its
- 16 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 17 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 18 persons or circumstances is not affected."
